**Key Job Responsibilities:**

- Perform all firefighting duties as assigned and outlined in department policy. Policy will be made available upon request.
- Perform all Emergency Medical Service (EMS) duties as assigned and regulated by departmental protocols and Texas Department of Health guidelines.
- Must satisfactorily pass all EMS protocol testing with the City Medical Director.
- Follow all departmental policies and procedures.
- Perform all other duties as directed by Supervisors.

**Knowledge / Skills:**

- Must possess a working knowledge of the Incident Management System, fire ground strategy and tactics, and current EMS patient care standards.
- Must possess operational knowledge of vehicle extrication techniques.
- Must be willing to work in a combination department composed of volunteer and Part-Time fire suppression personnel.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Must maintain a full time work status with a full time paid fire department, or may be retired with a minimum of 10 years of full time paid fire suppression experience. Or must be a full time employee of a fire/arson investigation agency with a strong fire suppression background.
- Have a basic Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) Structural Fire Fighter certificate
- Have a basic Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification or higher.
- Have a current Hazardous Materials – Operations certification.
- Fire Inspector certification preferred.
- Must pass a basic Firefighter physical.
